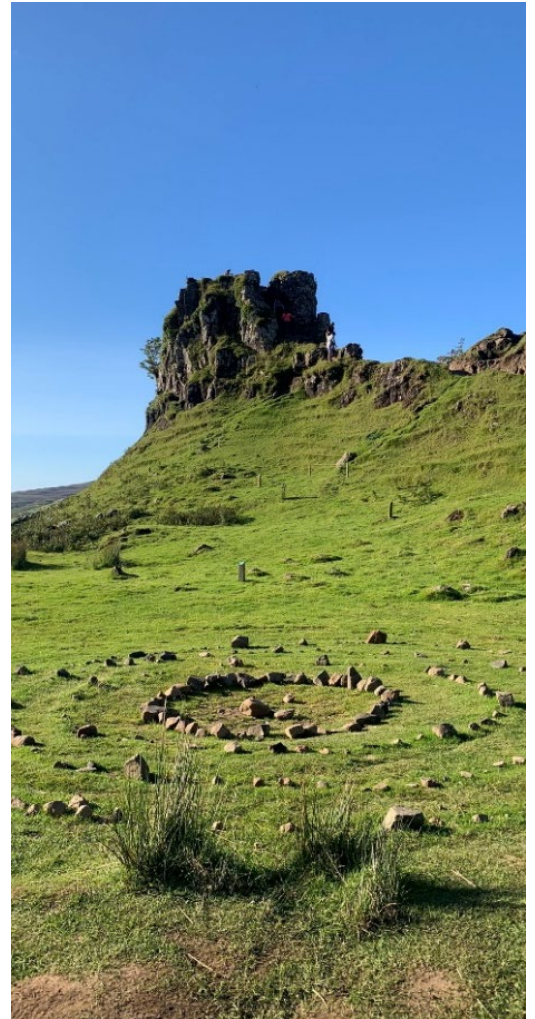

Through our expertise and local knowledge we'll discover ancient trails, search for the Skye Faeries, and have every sense piqued by the area's raw natural beauty, its awe-inspiring wildlife, and delicious flavours for an authentic, unforgettable Highland experience.

4 DAY TOUR ITINERARY

We'll spend Day 1 exploring Skye's northern loop trail. We'll take breakfast in Skye's quaint capital, Portree, before heading north to some of Skye's most iconic geological landmarks: The Old Man of Storr, the Quiraing, and Mealt Falls. We'll take in the dramatic ruin of Duntulm Castle before visiting the Skye Museum of Island Life to learn the folk history of Skye's historic inhabitants. We'll explore some hidden secret locations on our way to the port village of Uig, before exploring the magical Fairy Glen where we'll leave gifts and open our hearts to the Skye Faeries. We'll wrap up Day 1 back at Portree where we'll enjoy dinner and drinks.

On Day 2 we'll explore Skye's Central and Western locations, taking us through the village of Broadford and on to the iconic village of Sligachan under the Cuillins, before onwards to the beautiful Fairy Pools and Glen Brittle. We'll fuel up with a delicious lunch and then on to a stroll at Talisker Bay beach and waterfall on Skye's Western shores. We'll then head to the world famous Talisker Distillery where we'll take a tour and sample their offerings on a whisky tasting. We'll finish up our Day 2 at Broadford for dinner and drinks.

Day 3 will take us off the Isle of Skye to explore the surrounding Lochalsh and Strathcarron area. This day's tour is part of what makes Caol Tours special. Many who visit the Isle of Skye stay solely on the island for the duration of their trip and miss out on the extraordinary locations in the immediate surrounding area. We'll start our day touring the famous Eillean Donan Castle before a peaceful walk around the beautiful, abundant Attadale Estate Gardens. We'll head Strathcarron way where we'll visit some traditional Scottish crafting spots, before taking the infamous Bealach Na Ba road (Pass of the Cattle) where we'll enjoy some of the Highland's most beautiful vistas and panoramas, before onwards to the gorgeous village of Applecross for lunch on the shore. We'll then take in the historic fishing village and beautiful bay at Plockton, with some hidden secrets and highlights on the way.





Day 4 will take us to our favourite beach and coastal scenes on the island, with visits to the striking coastline at Neist Point Lighthouse and the dreamy, edge of the world Claigan Coral Beach via the quaint, ancient village of Dunvegan and its historic castle and grounds.

Neist Point Lighthouse, established 1909 by the famous Stevenson family, is set upon the cliffs on the westernmost point of Skye. Here we'll follow the contours of the cliffs as we make our way towards this incredible landmark, looking out for nesting fulmars and over to the Hebrides and Atlantic lying west.

At Dunvegan village we'll take lunch before heading to the historic Dunvegan Castle, built in the 13th century and the oldest continuously inhabited castle in Scotland at over 800 years, and ancestral seat of Clan MacLeod. Here we'll enjoy a tour of the castle grounds and gardens before a gentle boat trip to admire the resident seal colony.

We'll then head to one of Skye's most beautiful beaches, Claigan Coral Beach, on the Watnish Peninsula. Here on the north-west shore of Loch Dunvegan, we'll share one of the most picturesque scenes on the island; a crescent moon shaped white beach of a most unusual sand set against the Outer Hebridean Islands in the distance. Here we'll picnic, rest and enjoy the views. And should we take the notion, to jump into the ocean, we very well may do!

We'll be as active as our mobility and ambition requires, safe in the knowledge that hiking and hill climbing are optional, so you won't be pressed beyond your comfort zone. At a minimum, we'll walk over uneven ground for periods up to 1 hour. Talk to us. Let us make this a trip which fits you.
